

Requests for Non-Standard Mapping

Nicolson Digital (Nicolsons) can now consider requests for non-standard mapping in order to assist with the restrictions due to Covid-19. These can include pre-drawn routes on a map.

Here is the information you need to consider if you are thinking of using these facilities. There is an amended 2020 order form to encompass requests for Non-Standard Mapping.

If there are other types of non-standard map (ie not using OS 1:25000 mapping) that you wish to use, please advise TREC GB Admin and we can explore the possibilities.

We ask that the event organiser provides Nicolsons with the e-mail address and contact phone number of the person who will actually be checking the draft map and, with Nicolsons, dealing with any corrections to the route shown. This is to help create the non-standard mapping just in case they have any issues and need to speak to you. (This will save having to go through TREC GB Admin and have a three-way conversation.) Any e-mail or phone numbers that Nicolsons hold will be treated with the greatest of respect and they will fully comply with GDPR. The details will only be used by them for the purposes of making the map and for nothing else.

Making a Non-Standard map takes considerably longer than making a standard one. Nicolsons will endeavour to turn things round for you as fast as they can, however, if you are able to get your request in as early as possible, it will save anyone rushing and reduce the chance of making errors.

As the name implies a Non-Standard map is just that and, obviously, there are additional costs involved. The addition of either a Level one or two route on an A4 or A3 draft, will be charged at the cost of approx £40.

To add your route, you need to supply the route information as a .gpx file. Nicholsons will import this onto the base data. The output on the mapping will be shown as a line at 0.75pt in your choice of red/magenta/black.

For various reasons, there can be issues with importing the route information and in order to get it correct Nicolsons will e-mail a draft copy to the person you have nominated as the one to check it.

This must be printed out (not just viewed on the screen) as it needs to be checked at actual size and NOT as an on-screen enlargement. Any changes or alterations that are required should be sent to robin@nicolsonmaps.com as soon as possible.
