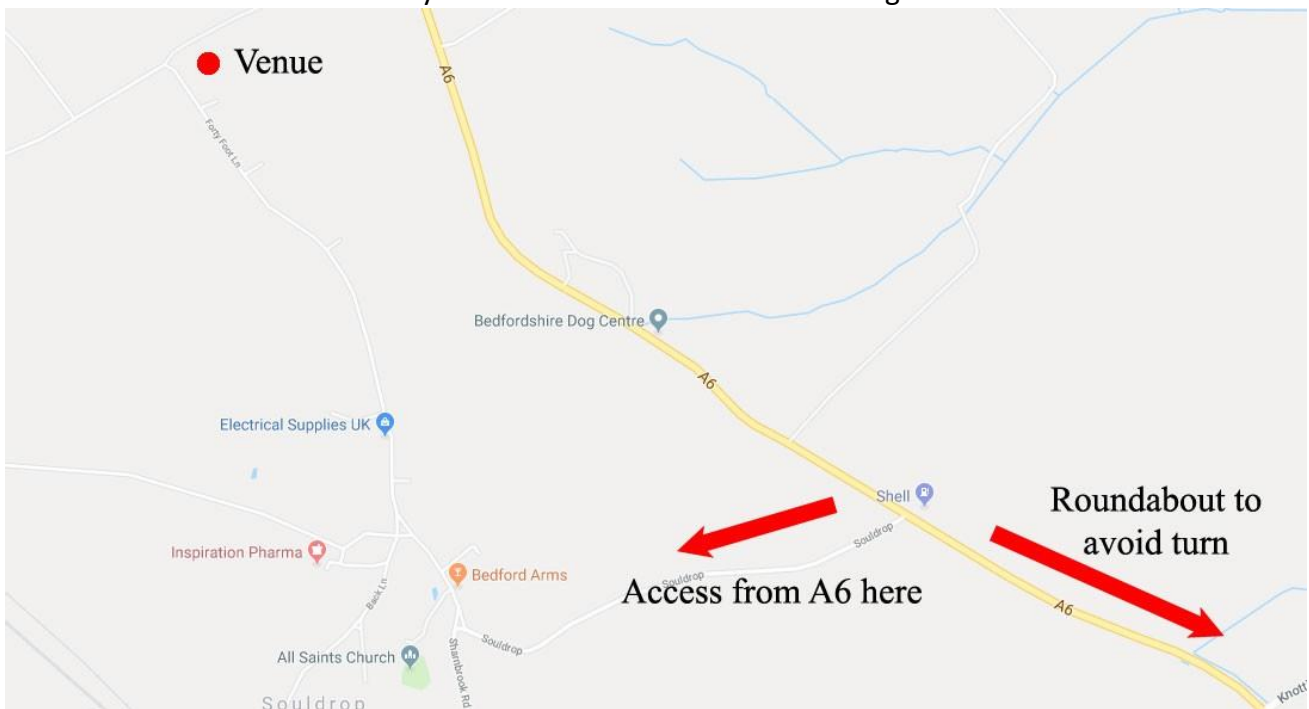

It is recommended that you access Souldrop via the A6 as the route from Sharnbrook is narrow and has a few tight turns. If coming from the north, there is a roundabout south-east of Sharnbrook on the A6 where you can turn around to avoid turning across traffic.



When passing through Souldrop turn right at both grass Triangles. Please be careful of parked cars on the High Street.

The nearest postcode to the venue is MK44 1HB. Keep following Chapel Lane all the way to end. The venue will be signposted.

Please use day parking for visitors and judges.

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# CHECK IN

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The Secretary will be available from 3pm on Friday for you to check in. Please bring your hat, body protector and horse's bridle including bit for inspection (the same bit must be used for all 3 phases). You can collect your championship souvenirs, bib and wristband (which will double as your meal ticket for Saturday evening meal if ordered).

**Please ensure your hat & body protector meet current TREC GB standards as per Appendix 2 of the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition of the British TREC Rulebook:**

If you would like to enter for the team competition, please let the Secretary know before 8pm (4 riders per team, £24 per team to enter).

Pre-ordered Commemorative clothing will also be available to collect from the Secretary.

## CORRALLING

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We have over 60 horses, so please keep your corrals to a reasonable size. Anyone taking up too much room will be asked to reduce the size of their corral so that we can fit everyone in. The corralling field has recently been cut for hay and therefore you are advised to bring your own hay/haylage with you.

**Your corral must be electrified and display a label giving your contact details (a template is available at the end of the Competitors' Information). All horses must wear a headcollar & have identification containing horse name & competitor number whenever it is loose in the corral. Please bring rugs in case of flies/rain/cool winds.**

Water is available in the field for equine consumption. Although the water is clean, it is not provided in a food grade pipe. There is a muck trailer provided, this is for muck only and must not contain any string, plastic or other matter.

If your horse is corralled and you are leaving the site, you must organise someone to keep an eye on your horse while you are away and must include this person's contact details on the label too.

**Due to the recent hot weather, please DO NOT use BBQs or smoke anywhere in the venue (including corralling & PTV field) due to the high fire risk.**

Please leave the site clean and tidy and take all rubbish home with you.

## CAMPING

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There is a separate area for tents and caravans – no tents for sleeping to be pitched in the corralling field. Please leave adequate space between tents and vehicles for fire safety reasons.



# DOGS

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All dogs **must be** on a lead. There will be livestock about, both on the venue and on the open land. You will be asked to pay a fine to the local Air Ambulance if you breach this rule. Repeated offenders will be asked to leave the venue and if a competitor, may be eliminated. Please pick up dog waste and take away with you.

On Sunday all horses will be vetted in PTV order as per the published times. All competitors are advised to allow their horses to stretch after travelling before presenting to the vet.

# THE PHASES

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## POR Phase

The Maproom will be before the Tack Check & Start. You will have 45 minutes on leaving the Maproom to get yourself and your horse ready and to present yourself to the Tack Check. Ensure you have plenty of drinks for yourself on the POR in the event of hot weather. All checkpoints will have water available for horses. Please consider any additional items you might require due to the excessive heat we have currently been experiencing e.g. sun cream, electrolytes for humans and horses.

**A reminder to all competitors: Riders are not permitted to wear or use any “smart” device (smart watch) capable of assisting with speed, distance or position.**



## **MA Phase**

The MA will be open for walking on Friday from 5pm. On Sunday, please be vigilant of times and be prepared to go either before or after your allocated time due to any unforeseen circumstances.

## **PTV Phase**

The PTV course will be open for walking on Friday from 5pm. There will be a guided course walk on Saturday 6pm – 7pm. On Sunday, please be vigilant of times, and be prepared to go either before or after your allocated time due to any unforeseen circumstances. Body protectors must be worn for the PTV. One PTV obstacle will be negotiated as part of the POR.
