

Rule changes/amendments for 2022

The 6th edition of the British TREC Rulebook 2022 contains all the rule changes since 2020.

The amendments and changes for 2022 are detailed below.

Changes are shown in **BOLD** type. Page numbers as per the 6th edition book.



Full TREC

- 3.3.4 Page 9: **Competitors must be 5 years or older to ride in competitions or any other TREC GB insured event**
- 3.10.1 Page 19: Distances now **L1 Up to 15km, L2 Up to 20km, L3 Up to 30km, L4 Up to 40km**
- 4.10.1 Page 29: Ticket points general: **These should be placed so they can clearly be seen by the riders when they are riding the correct route intended**
- 4.10.3 Page 30: Tickets control, bullet point 3 add: **or electronic recording devices ('dibbers')**
- 4.12.1 Page 31: Bearings section, general, add: **The final destination could be anywhere along this route**
- 6.2.2 Page 39: Course marking, add: **Crossed flags, in front of an obstacle, may be used by PTV course designers to indicate that the marked obstacle is not part of their class**
- 6.3.2 Page 40-41: Obstacles alter: Up to 2 'special obstacles' may be used, **except that in the TREC GB National and Grassroots Championships only obstacles listed in Appendix 6: PTV Obstacles may be used**
- A2.1 Page 59: Hat standards: **PAS 015 1998, SEI ASTM 95 and SNELL E2001 will be removed from the current list at midnight 31st December 2022**

S-7 Page 85: Rein Back, **Led Rein Back** has been added to the 'main' list of obstacles.

Page 95: Cloverleaf / Shamrock: Alter the Cloverleaf/ Shamrock consists of 3 loops to be ridden in **alphabetical order, in the direction stipulated by the course designer and indicated by letters and colour flags. Red is always on the right and White to your left. The two alternative layouts are shown here.** Page 96 States. **The rein A is to be ridden on will determine the position of B & C**

Arena TREC

A8.6.1 Page 122: Added: **Special obstacles may be used, in accordance with rule 6.3.2**

A8.6.2 Page 122: Added: **Time penalties may be applied at the discretion of the organiser, with 1 penalty incurred for every 6 seconds over the time.**
